



2019-20 HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

We will send you an email over the summer with details about purchasing your needed books for the upcoming school year. At the August 5th 2019-20 Kickoff! morning, you will select your locker.

Each teacher will have his or her own method of asking you to take notes, complete assignments, etc., and will give you details during the first week of class. However, generally speaking, you will need the following items:

- A means of note-taking and keeping assignments organized for each class. You may prefer a notebook and folder for each class, or binders with pocket folders and paper; the choice is yours.
- A TI-84 Plus graphing calculator (any version: Silver, C Silver, or CE)
- Loose leaf paper
- Pens, pencils, highlighters
- Backpack or bag (you may take these to class with you if you wish)
- All 9th graders must use a planner. (Planners are recommended, but not mandatory, for other grade levels.) You should have it with you at school and in every class, at all times. There are several options:
 - We have created a customized St. Francis planner, with important school dates included, and will send you information over the summer on how to buy it (along with how to purchase books).
 - If you prefer to use a planner that you have found on your own, that is also fine. It must have significant spaces for each day (it cannot be simply a monthly or weekly calendar).
 - If you have a technological device you plan on bringing to school (computer, iPad, etc.) that has a calendar feature you want to use, that too is acceptable. However, please do note above – it must be an item you plan to bring to each class, as you will need to add things to the calendar multiple times per day.
- OPTIONAL: The School has Chromebooks available via ChromeCarts for student use throughout each Division. Some students, however, prefer to bring and use their own laptops, which is fine. The School uses the HP Chromebook Education Edition 11G6. Parents are welcome to purchase these for their child's personal use if desired, and they are made by several different manufacturers. Parents may also purchase any other type of Chromebook or laptop with equivalent specs that can run Windows 10 or macOS Mojave (10.0 or newer).
